#### **GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH**

Nope, I can't help make you a better player. The tip of the month might make you a faster player, though, which will help your game and the overall pace of our tournaments.

June Tip: What's the most important shot in golf? It's the next shot! The time to start thinking about that all-important shot is right after the last shot. Now what? Go for the green? Lay up? Chip sideways from the trees or go for that tiny little opening toward the green? All that thinking takes time, so give it an early start and finish most of the brainwork before you get to your ball. This not only speeds up play, it will help you come to the best decision for your next shot. Give it a try—and forget about that little opening in the branches ahead, too.
