GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE/GOLF COURSE RULES

I've been asked by our President Mike Morrow to share some golf etiquette that we all need to be reminded of:

- -- Respect the players in your group by keeping up the pace of play.
- -- Avoid talking or making noise when other players are hitting.
- -- Do not stand directly behind a player when they are hitting.

- -- On the putting green, do not walk on a players line to the hole.
- -- Do not stand in front of or behind a player when they are putting.
- -- On the fairway, don't move ahead of a player until the player has hit their ball.
- -- Be ready when it's your turn.

GOLF RULES OF PLAY

Let's all of us remember a few of the most basic rules of golf:

- -- Play your ball as it lies; no bumping or improving the lie
- -- Keep track of your score, every stroke. None of this, "Give me a 6," or "I think mine was a 5." There is only one correct score, and it's up to each player to be fair and accurate in reporting their score for each hole.
