That left the two of them tied for final net score—the tiebreaker for the final nine holes went to Larry Sifuentes, our 2023 TRGC Club Champion. Bart Stevens finished third and Alan Staton closed out the top positions in fourth. Congratulations, Larry, and to Cosme, Bart and Alan for their fine finishes.
